SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

We are excited to see our Central Community back at school and want to make sure that we keep our school safe for everyone. At Central we have two options for learning.

IN CLASS LEARNING

- Students will be placed in a class
- Two classes are combined to be called a **Learning Group**
 - This Learning Group will not exceed **60 people**
 - The Learning Group may or may not combine at times
 - Learning Groups will be on a staggered schedule either Schedule A or Schedule B
 - Each Learning Group will have an assigned entry/exit
 - Learning Groups will have assigned lunch and recess times to limit the number of students outside
- Exploratory will happen but only over one term- each class will get three exploratories for the year
- Music will continue but differently than before and in Learning Groups wherever possible
 - When this is not possible, physical distancing is required
- Students **must wear masks** when not in their learning group, in any area that is high traffic and whenever physical distancing cannot happen
- Students **must hand wash or sanitize** when transitioning from one activity to another
- Some staff may work across different learning groups in order to provide support- they will wear PPE and remain physically distant
